- National Entry fee will be paid by the Organising committee;
- Lump sum grant as decided by the ACA to the selected players for Nationals;
- Two T-shirts (as decided by the ACA) to the selected players for nationals.
- 1/4th Rail ticket charges to the selected players for nationals.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Registration: All Players including Normal/Seeded/Selected should get their names registered in apchess.org in the link provided for the tournament. No player will be allowed without registering in the apchess.org (in case of web-site problem players should fill the google form provided by the organiser).

Age Limit: Players should have **been born on or after 01.01.2004.**

Eligibility: Age proof is required. Certificate should be from the Panchayat/Municipality or corporation obtained soon after birth. Players without the date of birth certificate will not be allowed to participate. As per the rules of AICF, only players whose dates of birth are registered within one year of their birth are permitted to take part in respective age group state/nationals. Other country passport holders shall not be allowed to participate in the State Chess Championship. Only Andhra Pradesh Players can participate in this championship.

Subject to the age limit, the following players can participate

- ❖ Every affiliated district/Special unit can field two players in each category.
- ❖ The top 2 rankers of the AP State Under-19 Boys and Girls Chess Championships held during 2022 are seeded to play here in respective category subject to age stipulation.
- ❖ In the event of an odd entry in any category, the N R G C h e s s a c a d e m y is entitled to add one more to make the total number even.
- ❖ Any player who pays the prescribed Special entry fee: Open: Rs.1000/- may be considered for participation and these entries should be duly recommended by their concern district chess association.
- ❖ The ACA President & Secretary can nominate one entry each.
- ❖ Any current national champion in any category is to be seeded to all statechampionships subject to age stipulation.
- ❖ Any current national No. 2 and 3 is to be seeded to the same category statechampionship subject to age stipulation.
- ❖ Any current World Champion in any category is to be seeded to all statechampionships subject to age stipulation.
- ❖ Any current World No. 2 and 3 are to be seeded to the same + one step higherstate championships subject to age stipulation.
- ❖ Any current Asian Champion is to be seeded to the same plus one step higher statechampionship subject to age stipulation.
- ❖ Any current Asian No. 2 and 3 are to be seeded to the same category subject to age stipulation.

- ❖ All GMs & IMs are seeded to all Open (boys) State Championships subject to age stipulation.
- ❖ Only Indian Nationals are eligible to participate.

Boarding & Lodging: Unfurnished dormitory/room type of lodging will be provided to seeded/selected players and one manager per team (Nominated by the district association). Players are requested to bring their own beddings. Canteen facilities are available on payment basis at the venue premises itself. All special entries and accompanying persons have to arrange accommodation on their own. Kindly note that accompanying persons of same gender alone will be permitted to stay together. A boy cannot stay with a female and a girl cannot stay with a male in the official accommodation provided.

AICF Player Registration: AICF player registration is compulsory for all players.

AICF Player Registration fee is Rs.250/- for the year 2023-2024.

AICF player registrations will be accepted only through online.

Players/Arbiters registration should be done well before the start of event (Championship).

For renewing AICF registration of existing players, please click <http://aicf.in/players/> and click extend membership.

For (New) Fresh AICF registration please click <http://aicf.in/online-player-registration/>. For fresh AICF registration, players are requested to keep their scanned passport size photograph and birth certificate and a valid email address (unique) not used by any other person/ player for AICF, ready before the registration process. Note: Only passport size (less than 1 MB) photographs in jpeg format should be uploaded.

Default Time: Default time is 15 minutes. Players have to be at the boards within 15 minutes of the start of the round.

Rules: FIDE rules in force shall apply.

System of Play: The Tournament shall be conducted on a Eight rounds Swiss System.

Time Control: 90 minutes each plus 30 seconds increment from the move one.

Tie-break: Buchholz Cut 1, Buchholz, Sonneborn Berger, Direct encounter, number of wins (forfeit included) and number of wins with Black. In case of tie, prizes will not be shared.

Chess Clocks: Each Association is requested to provide at least one chess clock for every two players.

Appeals Committee: An Appeals Committee comprising of three members plus two reserves will be formed at the Managers' meeting. All the members and reserves shall be from different districts. No member of committee can vote on dispute in which a player from his own district is involved and in such case(s), the reserve member takes his place. The decision of the appeals committee is final and binding on all players concerned.

Protest: Protest, if any against the decision of the Chief arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 500/- within 15 minutes of incident. The decisions of the appeals committee shall be final and binding on all concerned. The protest fee is refundable one if the protest is upheld.

Withdrawals: A player may withdraw from the tournament at any stage after informing the Chief Arbiter in writing.

Arrears: The players belonging to Districts which are in arrears to ACA will not be allowed to take part.

Rights of Admission: The ACA/Nandyal DCA/ organizer NRG Chess Academy reserve the rights of admission to the venue and lodging place.

Instruction to the District Chess Associations: Complaints against suspected over-aged players could be made with a fee of Rs.1000/- to the organizers before the end of the second round who shall medically verify the players concerned and the matter will be taken to AICF through ACA.

All entries whether 'regular' or 'special' should be routed through the respective district chess association on or before 31st May 2023. No entry will be entertained after **last date of entries**. Entry fee have to be paid through the following Bank account. All Entries should be recommended by their respective district chess associations.

Players from Districts where District Championships were not organized by the respective districts will be considered as Special entry only.

Food: All Players including Normal & Special should look after their own arrangements. However, Food will be available at the venue on payment basis.

Recommendation for Nationals: No player will be recommended by the ACA without participating in the State Championship.
