Rules & Regulations

» System of Play:

Both tournaments will be conducted as per FIDE Laws of chess and FIDE Swiss system with 09 rounds each.

» Time Control:

For Open : 90 minutes with 30 seconds increment from move no. 1

For Below 1800 : 30 minutes with 30 seconds increment from move no. 1

» Default Time:

For Open : 30 minutes (Walkover time).

For Below 1800 : 15 minutes (Walkover time)

» Tie-Breaks: In case of a tie, the latest FIDE / AICF rules shall come in to effect

1. Buchholz Cut 1
2. Buchholz
3. Sonneborn-Berger
4. Direct encounter
5. Number of wins including forfeits
6. Number of wins with Black pieces

» Eligibility:

For Open tournament : Any Rated or Unrated Player.

For below 1800 Tournament : Any rated player whose rating has not crossed 1799 in last 36 months prior to start of the tournament & Unrated Player is eligible to participate: Players who finished first or second in any rating restricted FIDE tournament will not be eligible to play in any rating restricted tournament for one year from the date of such achievement.

» General Regulations:

- ▶ **AICF Registration (Apr 2026 - Mar 2027):** Those who are not registered with the AICF, they must do AICF registration online at <http://prs.aicf.in/players> before sending
- ▶ **Electronic Device:** Any types of electronic device will not be allowed in the playing arena.
- ▶ **Wrist Watches:** All types of wrist watch will not be allowed in the playing arena.
- ▶ **Age Groups:** Players will get prize in his/her own age category not for higher age category.
- ▶ **Withdrawal:** Player may withdraw at any stage after informing to the Chief Arbiter in writing.
- ▶ **Spectators:** Parents / Coaches / Managers/ Player who have finished their games will be treated as spectators and are not allowed in playing hall.
- » ▶ **Protest:** If any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of ₹ 5,000/- within 30 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. Protest fee will be refunded if the appeal up held.
- » ▶ **Organizer Rights:** Organizer reserve right to accept / reject any entry without assigning any reason. Due to any unforeseen circumstances, if the event needs to be canceled, organisers obligation is limited to refunding the entry fee paid by the players.
- » ▶ **Prize Distribution:** All prize winners must attend the Prize distribution ceremony, otherwise no prize/certificates will be given to such players/without a valid reason.
- » ▶ **Certificates:** All participants will get e-Certificate(s).

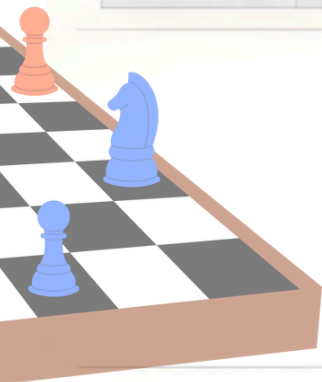

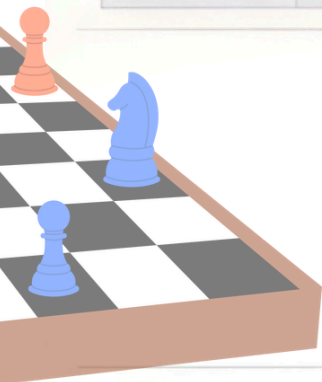

Registration & Entry Fee

»» **Entry Fee : Rs. 7,500/-**

Last Date for Entry : 25-05-2026

»» **Late Fee : Rs. 500/-** from 26th May onwards, subject to availability of slots.

»» **Cancellation & Refund Policy:**

- ▶ In case of cancellation, the entry fee will be refunded within 3 working days after receipt of the cancellation request. Cancellation requests can be made personally to the tournament officials or via email at chessandhra@gmail.com.
- ▶ Cancellation requests will be accepted only until the publication of the 1st round pairings on ChessResults. After the first-round pairings are published, no cancellation requests will be entertained.

Accommodation

»» Players are requested to make their own arrangements for accommodation.

However, If any player/parent requires accommodation inside the University campus, they may avail the following facilities:

»» **Type of Accommodation :**

- ▶ AC Room with attached bathroom (Double / Triple occupancy).

»» **Conditions :**

- ▶ Male and female accommodation will be arranged separately. Boys below 11 years are allowed inside the Ladies' accommodation. However, girls will not be allowed inside the Men's accommodation.

»» **Food :**

- ▶ North/South indian mixed breakfast, evening snacks and dinner will be served at designated dining areas.

»» **Purified Drinking Water:** Available inside the accommodation area. Players are requested to carry their own water bottles.

»» **Distance :**

- ▶ Within the University campus

»» **Accommodation Charges** (@ Rs. 600 pelay) for AC Sharing Accommodation
(@ Rs. 400 per day) for Non-AC Sharing Accommodation
